# Giving back is the co-op way

We are returning \$1.64 million to members

This month, your electric cooperative is returning \$1.64 million in patronage cash back to our members. That's money going right back into the hands of those who own the co-op — you!

This year's payments go to members who received service in 2010, with the average residential member getting \$142.

Payments will appear as a credit on your November bill or as a separate check mailed around Nov. 21.

Patronage cash back represents your ownership in the cooperative. Each dollar you spend helps maintain and improve our electric system, and when our finances allow,

those margins are returned to you. Since 1955, we've paid back more than \$45 million to members

and Midwest Electric continues to lead the

nation by returning a higher percentage of patronage than most other co-ops.

Even better, our 10-year financial forecast shows no distribution rate increases for several years — possibly not until 2030. That's stability you can count on.

We also continue to work on your behalf beyond electricity. By engaging with local and national leaders, we help shape policies that keep your power reliable and affordable. If you'd like to strengthen those efforts, consider contributing \$25 a year (\$2.08/month) to the America's Electric Cooperatives Political Action Committee, joining more than 700 fellow members supporting lawmakers who stand up for co-ops.
