PLUGGED INTO HISTORY



Learn about the history of your electric cooperative as we celebrate 90 years of service!

- Incorporated March 17, 1936, in Lima.
- Originally Western Farm Bureau Electric Cooperative
 - Split off in late 1936, early 1937.
 - Part became Midwest Electric Cooperative (St. Marys), and part became United Rural Electric Cooperative (Kenton; now Mid-Ohio Energy Cooperative).
- Our first substation, in 1937, had only a 300 kVa transformer
 - It served hundreds of homes and farms and was located near St. Marys. It served members from Wapak to Ft. Recovery. (Today, this size of a transformer could serve the equivalent of 30 homes).

Petition forms available to run for Midwest Electric's board of directors

Any member residing in a district up for election may become a candidate by obtaining a petition form from the co-op's office and obtaining at least 15 valid signatures of members who reside within that district. For this year's elections, petitions may be filed by members who reside in:

- **District 1 (3-year term): Auglaize & Shelby counties**
- **District 2 (3-year term): Allen & Putnam counties**

Candidates must complete the official petition packet available after March 18 and returned on or before 8 a.m. on May 1.

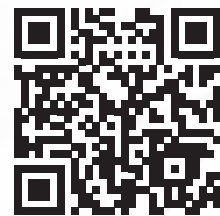
