Why Midwest Electric members are shielded from rate spikes

This past summer's prolonged heat and humidity caused higher electric use — and higher bills — for many Ohioans, including Midwest Electric members. However, unlike customers of investor-owned utilities (IOUs) such as AEP and AES, who saw rate hikes exceeding 25%, Midwest members were largely shielded from sharp price spikes.

That's because Midwest Electric operates differently. As a member-owned, not-for-profit cooperative, we provide electricity at cost and maintain stability through shared ownership in Buckeye Power, which generates electricity for Ohio's coops. Buckeye Power's diverse mix of coal, natural gas, solar, hydropower, and biogas facilities helps keep rates consistent and

reliable. Any excess power sold on the market generates revenue that offsets rising costs and is eventually returned to members as capital credits.

While co-ops still face rising costs to generate and deliver power, rate adjustments occur less often and are generally smaller. Despite serving fewer consumers per mile of line than investorowned utilities, Midwest Electric continues to offer highly competitive rates while upholding financial stability and dependable service for its members.





Smart Thermostat Rebate - \$100
